With Dubai Calendar's top picks of musical entertainment, discover new sounds from across the Middle East, South Africa, and more this month.



With an aim to bring together emerging talent from around the region to share a soulful stage, celebrating diversity, culture and alternative Arabism, WASLA is set to feature diverse cultural and artistic elements, with an array of great live entertainment and an immersive outdoor experience.











Dubai is also warming up to host the Irish boy band, Boyzone, for the last time during a historical performance at the Dubai Duty Free Tennis Stadium on 12 April. The band is set to rock the audience with tunes from their final album 'Thank You & Goodnight' as they celebrate 25 years of the band's journey to fame.

Additionally, singer-songwriter Ard Matthews of 'Just Jinjer' will share the stage with rock band Watershed at Dubai Opera on 18 April, bringing the contemporary rock landscape to life as it harmonises with a traditional South African repertoire. The unique performance will showcase sultry melodies and a line-up of hit rock songs that bring alive the musical lineage of the country.

Irish Village will host a live performance by Scottish music duo, The Proclaimers, in a vibrant evening of toe-tapping tunes and folksy rock songs on 25 April. Prepare for an evening of chart-topping hits, which have been featured in the soundtracks of big-time TV/film scores like Dumb and Dumber, Shrek, How I Met Your Mother and Pitch Perfect.
